La Laguna di Comacchio è costituita da una grande valle salmastra, ricca di barene ricoperte da vegetazione alofila; è attraversata da sud a nord dal cordone fossile sabbioso che costituisce la penisola di Boscoforte; l'area a ovest di Boscoforte presenta acque più aperte, rispetto alla zona ad est abbondante di dossi; la parte nord-est è costituita dalle Saline di Comacchio e a nord si trovano le acque aperte della Valle Fattibello. Nella parte nord-ovest del Sito si trovano la Valle Pega e la Valle Zavelea con acque dolci, così come acque dolci si trovano a sud-ovest in Valle Umana e in numerosi bacini isolati a scopo itticolturale.

Specie vegetali CORINE appendice K: *Bassia hirsuta*. RARISSIME e MINACCIATE: *Triglochin maritimum*, *Bassia hirsuta*, *Halocnemum strobilaceum*. RARE e MINACCIATE: *Plantago cornuti*, *Limonium bellidifolium*. E' uno dei siti più importanti d'Europa per Laridi (*Larus melanocephalus*, *Larus ridibundus*, *Larus genei*) e Sternidi (*Gelochelidon nilotica*, *Sterna sandvicensis*, *Sterna bengalensis*, *Sterna hitundo*, *Sterna albifrons*) nidificanti. Inoltre nidificano *Platalea leucorodia*, *Egretta alba*, *Recurvirostra avosetta*, *Himantopus himantopus*. Altre specie importanti sono *Tadorna tadorna*, con 77 coppie, *Anas strepera*, *Tringa totanus*, *Charadrius alexandrinus*. Importante anche per lo svernamento di grandi contingenti di *Egretta alba*, Anatidae e *Fulica atra*. Per la Pianura Padana è l'ultimo sito dove in passato veniva segnalata *Lutra lutra*, e uno degli ultimi d'Italia. *Pomatoschistus canestrini* e *Knipowitschia panizzae* trovano qui un habitat importante.
