During the charging process, the closing and opening springs are charged. This ensures that the switch-disconnector/fuse combination can switch off all types of faults reliably even during closing.

Closing and opening is done via pushbuttons, and is therefore identical with the operation of circuit-breaker operating mechanisms.

An energy store is available for tripping by means of an operating HV HRC fuse or via a shunt release (f-release).

After tripping, a red bar appears on the switch position indication.

#### Trip-free mechanism

The vacuum circuit-breaker is fitted with a trip-free mechanism according to IEC/EN 62271-100/VDE 0671-100. In the event of an opening command being given after a closing operation has been initiated, the moving contacts return to the open position and remain there even if the closing command is sustained. This means that the contacts are momentarily in the closed position, which is permissible according to the above-mentioned standard.

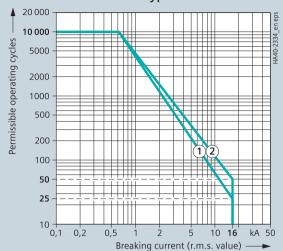

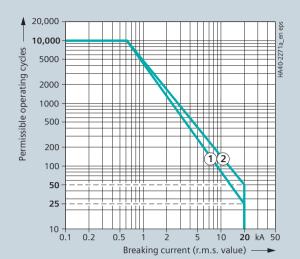

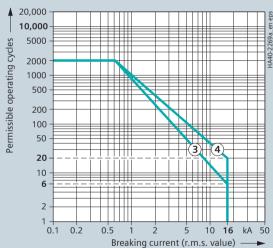


Rated short-circuit breaking current 16 kA

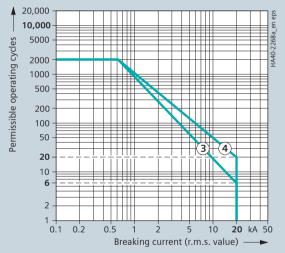


Rated short-circuit breaking current 20 kA

### Components

Busbar extension, modularity

#### **Features**

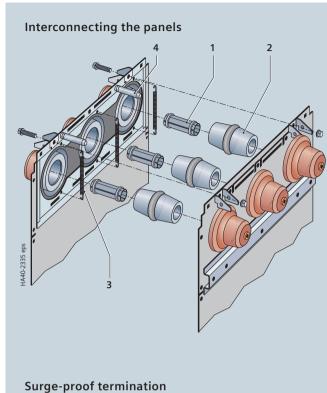

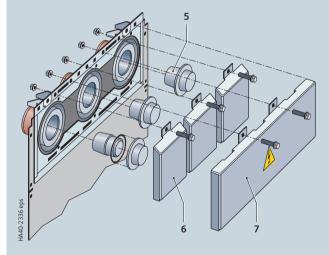
Every switchgear block and every individual panel is optionally available with busbar extension on the right, on the left or on both sides. This offers a high flexibility for the creation of switchgear configurations the functional units of which are lined up in any order. Local installation and lining up is done without gas work.

Lining up takes place as follows:

- By the busbar couplings on the medium-voltage side. Tolerances between adjacent panels are compensated by spherical fixed contacts and the movable contact coupling with degrees of freedom in all axis directions.
- By safe dielectric sealing with screened silicone couplings that are externally earthed and adjustable to tolerances. These silicone couplings are pressed on with a defined pressure when the panels are interconnected.
- On free busbar ends, screened dummy plugs are inserted, each of which is pressed on through a metal cover. A common protective cover with a warning is fixed over all three covers.
- By centering bolts for easier switchgear installation and fixing of adjacent panels.
- By bolted panel joints with defined stops for the distances between adjacent panels and the associated pressure of contact pieces and silicone couplings.

Switchgear installation, extension or replacement of one or more functional units requires a lateral wall distance  $\geq$  200 mm.

#### Mode of operation

In the event that an HV HRC fuse-link has tripped, the switch-disconnector is tripped via an articulation which is integrated into the cover of the fuse box (see figure).

In the event that the fuse tripping fails, e.g. if the fuse has been inserted incorrectly, the fuse box is protected by thermal protection. The overpressure generated by overheating trips the switch via the diaphragm in the cover of the fuse box and via an articulation. This prevents the fuse box from incurring irreparable damage.

This thermal protection works independently of the type and design of the HV HRC fuse used. Like the fuse itself, it is maintenance-free and independent of any outside climatic effects.

Furthermore, the HV HRC fuses (e.g. make SIBA) release the striker depending on the temperature and trip the switch-disconnector as early as in the fuse overload range.

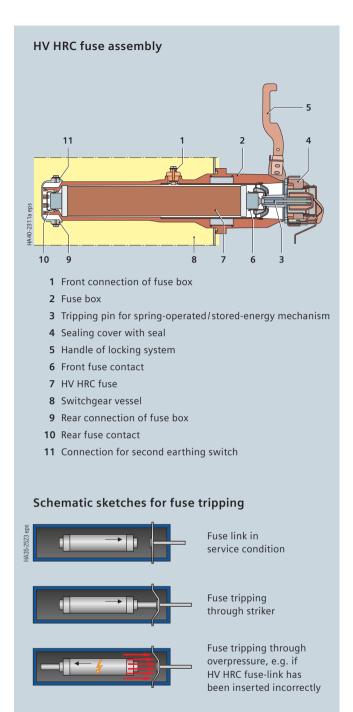
Impermissible heating of the fuse box can be avoided in this way.

#### Replacement of HV HRC fuse-links

- Isolate and earth the transformer feeder
- Open the cover of the fuse access
- Replace the HV HRC fuse-link.

#### Note to HV HRC fuse-links

According to IEC 60282-1 (2009) Clause 6.6, the breaking capacity of HV HRC fuses is tested within the scope of the type test at 87% of their rated voltage. In three-phase systems with resonance-earthed or isolated neutral, under double earth fault and other conditions, the full phase-to-phase voltage may be available at the HV HRC fuse during breaking. Depending on the size of the operating voltage of such a system, this applied voltage may then exceed



87% of the rated voltage. It must therefore already be ensured during configuration of the switching devices and selection of the HV HRC fuse that only such fuse-links are used, which either satisfy the above operating conditions, or whose breaking capacity was tested at least with the maximum system voltage. In case of doubt, a suitable HV HRC fuse must be selected together with the fuse manufacturer.

#### Allocation of HV HRC fuses and transformers

The following table shows the recommended HV HRC fuse-links make SIBA (electrical data valid for ambient air temperatures of up to  $40\,^{\circ}\text{C}$ ) for fuse protection of transformers.

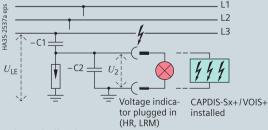

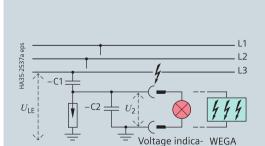

RTUs (Remote Terminal Units) can be optionally integrated inside the switchgear, in additional lowvoltage compartments, or in a separate wall cubicle via a plug connection.

In this way, the switchgear fulfills all preconditions for integration in an intelligent network infrastructure. Depending on the purpose, different components for monitoring and control are used: These components can also be easily and quickly retrofitted at a later time. An equipment example for the switchgear is illustrated here.

#### Type of service location

8DJH 36 switchgear can be used as indoor installation according to IEC 61936 (Power Installations exceeding AC 1 kV) and VDE 0101.

- Outside lockable electrical service locations at places which are not accessible to the public. Enclosures of switchgear can only be removed with tools.
- Inside lockable electrical service locations. A lockable electrical service location is a place outdoors or indoors that is reserved exclusively for housing electrical equipment and which is kept under lock and key. Access is restricted to authorized personnel and persons who have been properly instructed in electrical engineering. Untrained or unskilled persons may only enter under the supervision of authorized personnel or properly instructed persons.

#### Terms and definitions

"Make-proof earthing switches" are earthing switches with short-circuit making capacity according to IEC 62271-102 and VDE 0671-102/EN 62271-102.

#### Dielectric strength

- The dielectric strength is verified by testing the switchgear with rated values of short-duration power-frequency withstand voltage and lightning impulse withstand voltage according to IEC 62271-1/VDE 0671-1 (see table "Dielectric strength").
- The rated values are referred to sea level and to normal atmospheric conditions (1013 hPa, 20 °C, 11g/m3 humidity according to IEC 60071 and VDE 0111)
- The dielectric strength decreases with increasing altitude.
   For site altitudes above 1000 m (above sea level) the standards do not provide any guidelines for the insulation rating, but leave this to the scope of special agreements.

The gas insulation at a relative gas pressure of 50 kPa permits switchgear installation at any desired altitude above sea level without the dielectric strength being adversely affected. This also applies to the cable connection when plug-in sealing ends are used.

A decrease (reduction) of the dielectric strength with increasing site altitude must only be considered for panels with HV HRC fuses as well as for air-insulated metering panels and a site altitude of 1000 m (above sea level).

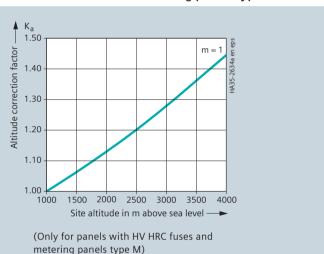

## Standards

Standards, specifications, quidelines

#### **Current carrying capacity**

- According to IEC 62271-200 or IEC 62271-1,
   VDE 0671-200 or VDE 0671-1, the rated normal current refers to the following ambient air temperatures:
- Maximum of 24-hour mean + 35 °C
- Maximum + 40 °C
- The current carrying capacity of the panels and busbars depends on the ambient air temperature outside the enclosure.

#### Appearance of internal faults

In gas-insulated switchgear 8DJH 36, faults leading to internal arcing are widely excluded by the construction due to the following measures:

- Use of gas-filled switchgear compartments
- Use of suitable switching devices such as three-position switches with make-proof earthing switch
- Logical mechanical interlocks
- Use of metal-enclosed voltage transformers, and current transformers as ring-core transformers (exception: air-insulated billing metering panel)
- There are no effects due to external influences, such as
- Pollution layers
- Humidity
- Small animals and foreign objects
- Maloperation is practically excluded due to logical arrangement of operating elements
- Short-circuit-proof feeder earthing by means of the three-position switch-disconnector.

In the event of an arc fault at the cable connection or in the unlikely case inside the switchgear vessel, pressure relief is effected downwards into the cable basement.

For the use in substation buildings without internal arcing test, such as "old substations", the switchgear can be designed with a modified pressure relief system with absorbers (option).

As a "special cooling system", this maintenance-free pressure absorber system reduces the pressure-dependent and thermal effects of internal arcing in switchgear vessels and cable compartments, and thus protects people and buildings.

The closed system is suitable for both wall-standing and free-standing arrangement.

#### Internal arcing test (design option)

- Protection of operating personnel by means of tests for verifying the internal arc classification
- Internal arcing tests must be performed in accordance with IEC/EN 62271-200/VDE 0671-200 for IAC (internal arc classification)
- Definition of criteria:
- Criterion 1

Correctly secured doors and covers do not open, limited deformations are accepted

- Criterion 2

No fragmentation of the enclosure, no projection of small parts above  $60\ g$

#### Climate and environmental influences

All parts of the primary circuit of the 8DJH 36 switchgear which are subjected to high voltage are completely enclosed and insensitive to climatic influences.

- All medium-voltage devices (except for HV HRC fuses) are installed in a gas-tight, welded stainless-steel switchgear vessel which is filled with SF<sub>6</sub> gas
- Live parts outside the switchgear vessel are provided with single-pole enclosure
- At no point can creepage currents flow from highvoltage potentials to earth
- Operating mechanism parts which are functionally important are made of corrosion-resistant materials
- Bearings in the operating mechanism are designed as dry-type bearings and do not require lubrication.

The 8DJH 36 switchgear is suitable for application in indoor installations under normal operating conditions as defined in the standard IEC 62271-1.

Furthermore, the high-voltage part of 8DJH 36 switchgear can be used in environmental conditions of the climatic category 3C2 according to the standard IEC 60721-3-3.

8DJH 36 has been subjected to a climatic test according to IEC 60932, Level 2, and is suitable for operating conditions according to "Design Class 2".

These tests also meet the requirements of IEC 62271-304 for "Design Class 2".

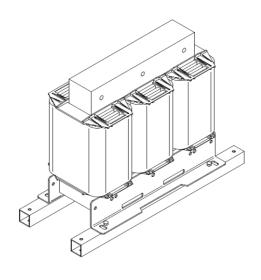

The INGECON® SUN Plant Controller helps the grid operator to manage the PV plant performance and to guarantee the quality and stability of the electricity supply.

#### Maximum PV plant control

An advanced algorithm combined with a fast and efficient communications system, with response times of less than one second, allows for a precise control of the active and reactive power delivered by the plant to the grid.

The INGECON® SUN Plant Controller controls the PV inverters, ensuring compliance with the grid operator's requirements at the PV plant connection point. It is also possible to manage energy storage systems and other devices such as diesel generators, through the use of INGECON® SUN STORAGE Power inverters.

This is a flexible system that can easily be adapted to the needs and configurations of each particular plant, whilst complying with the country-specific standards and regulations.

# Continuous communication with all the devices

The Power Plant Controller dynamically receives the grid operator's setpoints. For this purpose, a number of communication protocols are incorporated such as Modbus TCP / RTU, DNP3, IEC 60870-5-101, IEC 60870-5-104 and OPC UA. Likewise, it is also possible to add digital and analogue I/O mo-dules in order to extend the communication capabilities with third-party devices.

Furthermore, the INGECON® SUN Plant Controller permits communication with the plant SCADA to transmit the connection point data. It is also possible a manual control for temporary maintenance or engineering operations.







#### Plant Controller

#### Description of the complete system

A PV plant with a plant controller typically consists of:

- INGECON® SUN Plant Controller, comprising two basic systems: metering and control. It can additionally incorporate a communication channel with the grid operator in order to receive the operating setpoints.
- INGECON® SUN PV inverters connected to the PV array.
- INGECON® SUN STORAGE battery inverters connected to the energy storage system.
- SCADA, plant monitoring system.

 Communications network. Connecting the INGECON® SUN Plant Controller with the different inverters, transmitting the operating setpoints and monitoring the status of the equipment.

#### Operating mode

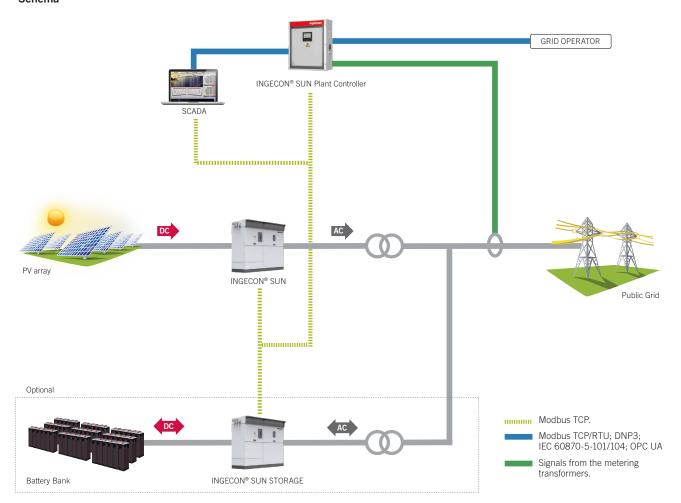
For the control, the INGECON® SUN Plant Controller takes the following data:

- Active power, reactive power, voltage and frequency at the point of connection, provided by the integrated metering unit.
- Grid operator requirements. To establish references for parameters such as voltage at the point of connection, ac-

tive and reactive power, power ramps, active power reserve, etc. These requirements can be predetermined either by the grid operator or by the plant operator or dynamically modified through an external setpoint.

- Instantaneous values of the various elements inside the plant: inverters, batteries, weather stations, reactive power compensation systems.
- With all these data, the controller can determine the optimum operating setpoints for each inverter integrated into the system and transmit the setpoints through the communications network.

#### System Features

#### **Production Control**

Some of the active power control functions that can be implemented in the IN-GECON® SUN Plant Controller are:

- Active Power Curtailment. It controls the PV plant's output power, limiting it to a desired value.
- Ramp Rate Control. It controls the power generated by the inverters, ensuring that the variation in the plant power output conforms to the established setpoint. So as to control control any power variation, it is necessary to add an energy storage system.
- Fast Frequency Regulation. The system adjusts the power production depending on the frequency variations.
- Energy Time Shifting. This control mode enables an advanced power generation planning, making the power plant's production profile unmatch the consumption profile.
- P Open Loop. This operating mode allows for controlling the active power generated at the inverter's terminals, and thus any inverter working point.
- Hybrid Self-Consumption. An energy storage system allows for a more optimised use of solar energy, utilising the energy stored to compensate the surplus or shortfalls of solar power, while controlling the active power injected to the grid.
- Two models available:

Standard version

- Uninterrupted Power Supply. When a grid-tied system becomes an isolated one as a consequence of a distant interruptor opening, the power plant can create an AC grid in order to feed the loads.
- Stand-Alone Generation. In this mode, one of the inverters will create an AC grid by generating an AC voltage and frequency for the loads and the other inverters.
- Solar Power Reserve. The INGE-CON® SUN Plant Controller incorporates a incorporates an innovative control strategy to guarantee an active power reserve with no need to include storage systems (depending on the availability of the PV resource), although it is also compatible with the addition of an ESS.

#### **Grid Support**

Some of the reactive power control functions that can be implemented in the IN-GECON® SUN Plant Controller are:

- On Demand Q. The system developed by Ingeteam allows to control the reactive power output, adjusting it to a given reference.
- Power Factor Control. Regulation of the power factor at the point of connection.
- Black Start Capability. The system can restore the electric supply dur-

ing a blackout by creating an AC network to power the loads.

Plant Controller

- Q Open Loop. This operating mode allows for controlling the reactive power generated at the inverter's terminals, and thus any inverter working point.
- Dynamic Reactive Compensation.
   With this mode, the reactive power at the point of connection can be compensated up to any desired value, 24 hours a day.

The Plant Controller allows to implement a control strategy to minimise these oscillations in both stationary and transitory regimes.

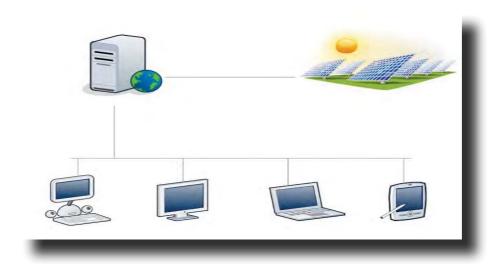






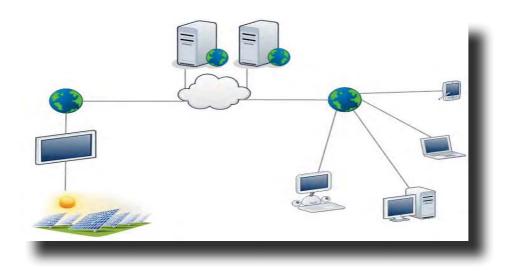
## Standalone solution

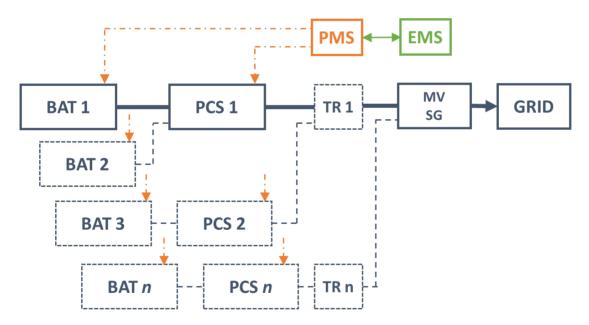


## 1 Introduction

# 4 Fire safety protection

Protection against major fire events and thermal abnormal situations are based on:

- Installation of battery container far from critical devices of the plant.
- Proper management of ventilation and temperature control of battery container.
- Proper thermal insulation of battery container to avoid unexpected heat transfer.
- Installation of an automatic fire detection system.
- Gas-based fire extinguishing system installed on LV container automatically activated by the smoke detector.
- Availability on site of local fire extinguisher

The BESS container is equipped with the firefighting system that is composed by a detection system, an extinguishing system and a central firefighting unit:

- The detection system is composed by smoke and temperature sensors installed on the ceiling of each room, ad by a smoke analyzer unit that are connected to the central fire-fighting unit. In each room there are at least 2 smoke and temperature detection sensors.
- The extinguishing system is composed by the bottles that contains the inert extinguisher gas, the distribution pipes and the nozzles. Each room is provided with the suitable number of nozzles in order to assure an homogeneous saturation of the room.

In case that one sensor detects smoke, the central fire-fighting unit issues the first threshold of alarm that result in to a stop of the BESS, and the issuing of the alarm to the customer supervision system.

In case that two sensors of the same room detect smoke, the central fire-fighting unit issues the second threshold of alarm that result in to a shutdown of the BESS, the releasing of the extinguisher and the issuing of the alarm to the customer supervision system.

Automatic smoke and fire detection system are made of:

- Addressable fire detection control panel.
- Lead backup batteries.



- Electronic smoke detectors.
- Alarm push button.
- Emergency light (visual/acoustic signaling device).
- Emergency buzzer (addressable audio/visual devices).
- Fire resistant cables.

Gas-based fire extinguishing system installed on battery container automatically activated by the smoke detector installed on battery cabinet.

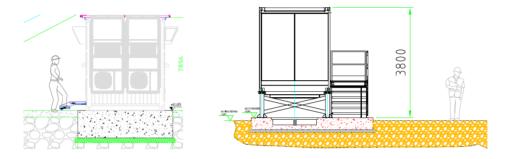
For the extinguishing system will be used an inert gas. The type of used gas is linked to the battery's manufacturer prescriptions. The main characteristic of inert gases (like helium, neon, argon, crypton and xenon) is that of not taking part in chemical reactions and it is for this characteristic that they prevent the development of combustion. Inert gas fire-fighting systems use argon and nitrogen gases and their mixtures as extinguishing agents, with the technique of total saturation of the environment up to a value below which the combustion process cannot to occur, but in any case such as not to constitute a danger for any operators.

Inert gases as extinguishing agents are particularly suitable for the protection of all environments where water cannot be used.



## 5 BESS installation and erection

The containers and equipment (i.e. battery container, PCS, MV, etc.) could be laid on foundation slabs in reinforced concrete or in elevation on metal structures; this second solution secures the equipment from possible risks of flooding and protects the system more from accumulations of dust.



Example of site installation container on the ground or on metal structures

The power and control cables between containers will be laid inside cable ducts obtained from the foundation slabs. For cable external to the foundations slabs they will be covered by means of fiberglass plots or solutions with a pipe embedded in the concrete.

A space of 3 meters per side must be guaranteed around the battery container, to guarantee the assembly and maintenance activities required by the battery container, such as transit and manoeuvring for inserting or extracting the modules.

On the container installation zone no additional treatment are needed except the collection and disposal of the rainwater.

Battery container does not foresee emissions of any kind in terms of gas or liquid during operation.



# 6 Decommissioning plan

SAET, being active as battery importer is properly enrolled, according to Italian Law "D. Lgs 188/2008" to the Italian battery logbook "Registro Pile e Accumulatori" and selected Italian COBAT consortium to support recycling process including decommissioning activities.
