Valle laterale del Fiume Potenza aperta verso Nord e delimitata dai monti Crispiero (m 835), Aria (m 956) e S. Pacifico (m 806), nella quale si trovano numerose grotte, con vegetazione muscinale ricca di felci e di fanerogame; in tutta la zona sono sviluppati boschi di caducifoglie termofile (orniello, carpino nero e roverella) e qualche lembo di sclerofille sempreverdi (leccio). Orno-Ostryetum : 40%
