The international workshop takes place when the issue of participation and transparency in environmental assessments is debated in the International, European and Italian regulatory framework in order to improve the effectiveness of environmental policies and their sustainability, in the light of the goals of the 2030 Agenda of the United Nations. At European and national level, the theme is central to the REFIT Program of the Strategic Environmental Assessment Directive and to the implementation of public debate on major infrastructural and architectural works of social importance (DPCM n. 76 of 10 May 2018).

The workshop aims at comparing some actors at national and international level, starting from the Charter of Principles for transparency and participation in Environmental Assessments, preliminarily discussed during the workshop held on 20 September 2018 and shared with regional administrations.

The workshop is also intended to identify and promote, through the adherence to the Charter of Principles, paths, innovative tools and best practices to improve information, consultation and participation processes in Environmental Assessments.

The results of the workshop and the proposals that will emerge will represent a heritage for the experimentation, in agreement with public administrations and stakeholders, of the Charter's principles, contributing at the same time to accelerating the path towards the goals of sustainability through transparent and participatory evaluation processes.
